- Every weekend throughout our 9-state area, MAGDRL volunteers are at local pet stores promoting dog owner education and adoptions.
- Our volunteers support other humane groups by attending their events and setting up MAGDRL information and merchandise tables
- MAGDRL sells merchandise at annual Great Dane National Specialty dog show at various U.S. locations.
- We sponsor annual Dog Owner Education brunch events that feature a delightful meal plus local and nationally-known guest speakers.
- MAGDRL holds Annual Dog Walks in several locations that attract vendors and sponsors plus a host of visitors with their dogs.
- Every holiday season members volunteer to take PetSmart's photos with Santa Claws for which MAGDRL gets donations that help our orphans.
